Message from the President



■ China Celebration of the International Day of Education

Answering the call of the resolution adopted by the General Assembly on the International Day of Education on December 3, 2018, CEAIE hosted the 2021 China Celebration of the International Day of Education on January 20, under the patronage of UNESCO and with the support of Chinese National Commission for UNESCO.

The theme of the China Celebration was Educational Equality and Sustainable Development in the Post-Pandemic Era, responding to the official theme of the International Day of Education Recover and Revitalize Education for the COVID-19 Generation. The event honored the pivotal position of education in social development, aimed to understand the current trends and issues, identified key lessons learned from the COVID-19 crisis, and shared experiences in responding to the immediate challenges in the face of education disruption. Taking what had been shared and explored in the event, we proposed long-term plans that sought to tackle the negative impacts of the COVID-19 pandemic on the society, and eventually accelerated the revitalization process of education and the realization of Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) proposed in 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development.

The event began with the welcome remarks from Dr. Liu Limin, President of CEAIE, and video messages from H.E. Ambassador Tijjani Muhammad-Bande, President of the 74th Session of the United Nations General Assembly. H.E. Ms. Stefania Giannini, UNESCO Assistant Director-General for Education inserted in her video speech the overarching principles and goals of the celebration of the International Day of Education. H.E. Mr. Tian Xuejun, Chinese Vice Minister of Education and the Chairperson of the Chinese National Commission for UNESCO delivered the keynote speech, in which he introduced China's practices in forwarding SDGs, educational achievements, as well as current policies and measures in restoring education during the outbreak of the COVID-19 pandemic. Around 1,000 provincial government officials, representatives from international organizations, Chinese teachers and students participated in the event.

Diplomats from 13 embassies in China and representatives from 3 international organizations including UNESCO Beijing Office attended the event. More than 20 media outlets covered the event. The event was also featured on UNESCO's official web page and UNESCO's Chinese official Twitter page.

In December, the 7th Meeting of CCHEIC was held to promote the sustainable development of educational cooperation between China and CEEC. The meeting hosted nearly 500 participants from China and CEEC in person and virtually. The 2021 China-CEEC Education Joint Project was launched, receiving a total of 45 project applications jointly proposed by 37 Chinese

universities and 57 CEEC higher education institutions. The CCHEIC has established 10 Academic Networks for development of key disciplines.

CEAIE and Greek Ministry of Education and Religious

Affairs jointly established the Advisory Committee for the Chinese and Greek Cooperation in Higher Education, which exemplified new channels for educational cooperation between China and European countries.



In response to the commitment made by President Xi Jinping at the Beijing Summit of the Forum on China-Africa Cooperation, the Luban Workshop Alliance was established under CEAIE's supervision, with the aim of supporting TVET going-global initiatives. The Alliance has set up an expert pool of 99 specialists to provide professional support and quality assurance.

In partnership with the Association of Technical University and Polytechnics in Africa (ATUPA), CEAIE implemented a Future of Africa-China TVET Cooperation

Program which engages 28 pilot universities and colleges in China and 12 countries in Africa. It consisted of various sub-projects in terms of curriculum development, student services, capacity building and skills certificate development.

The program provided online + offline training for more than 200 African teachers from over 30 colleges and universities in 9 countries focusing on pedagogy, technical skills, on-site training as well as TVET achievements in China.

In partnership with China Chamber of Commerce for Import and Export of Machinery and Electronic Products, CEAIE is engaged to promote cooperation among Chinese and African TVET institutions, industrial organizations, chambers of commerce and enterprises. The two organizations jointly released an *Initiative for Strengthened China-Africa Industry-Education Integration*.

PathPro Project provided integrated solutions for improving quality and international competitiveness of TVET institutions. It brought in high-quality TVET resources and provided tailor-made program solutions including transnational education programs, overseas delivery programs, capacity building programs, curriculum development and standard setting, international accreditation etc. In 2021, PathPro project provided training for administrators and teachers from TVET institutions.

In 2018, CEAIE officially launched China-ASEAN 100+100 Institutional Cooperation Flagship Program, which was designed to establish a steady and long-term platform in vocational education and training, and to encourage indepth, diversified and substantial collaboration between TVET institutions and industries of China and ASEAN countries. The Program created successful models of TVET cooperation regarding overseas delivery of education, study in

China, teacher capacity building and joint talent training, which unfolds promising prospect for building a China-ASEAN TVET community. CEAIE organized a variety of TVET events during the 2021 China-**ASEAN Education Cooperation** Week in Guiyang with about 500 offline participants and 180,000 online viewers. The 2021 China-ASEAN Rising Star Innovation Lab invited a total of 60 Chinese and ASEAN TVET students to bring their creative ideas and entrepreneurship on business solutions, and demonstrate how their business models might benefit the communities and industries for both China and ASEAN countries.

During the China-ASEAN TVET Hi-Tea Forum, CEAIE introduced the TVET reform and practices in China to the education officials from the ASEAN country embassies.

In response to the promulgation of the Measures for the Employment and Management of Foreign Teachers (for Trial Implementation), CEAIE provided assistance in developing supporting materials, such as "National Foreign Teachers Comprehensive Information Service Platform" to actively promote the construction of national foreign teachers comprehensive

information service platform. Initiatives were made to build connections with institutions in U.K., U.S., New Zealand, Ireland and other countries for expanding foreign teacher recruitment channels. The Teach in China program was steadily promoted in teaching of French, Spanish and other languages. More efforts were made to develop online English teacher classroom program to help improve English teaching in K-12 education.

In 2021, CEAIE continued to carry out the Foreign Coaches Supporting Football on Campus program. CEAIE undertook the work of the secretariat of the International Exchange Committee of the Third National Campus Football Expert Committee, issued the plan for the employment of foreign football teachers in the 2021 "Mantianxing" training camps and provided support service for 110 "Mantianxing" training camps across the country. A series of Chinese and foreign football coach exchange

To help educators and young people acquire competence as global citizens in the fast-changing and globalized world, AFS China carried out a series of programs of Education for International Understanding for teachers and students in primary and high schools across the country. As a blended learning program, the AFS Global Competence Certificate (GCC) was organized to provide educators and students with an online multinational platform to develop tangible global skills essential to live, work, and succeed around the world.



Quality Assurance

Leading the International Education Sector



The year 2021 witnessed the successful completion of the initial accreditation of 20 universities in Higher General Education Accreditation for International Students in China (HGEAIS) program, among which Shanghai Jiao Tong University and Renmin University of China earned the accreditation for the first time for 8-year and 6-year validity respectively. CEAIE initiated re-accreditation among the first two batches of HGEAIS

pilot universities. The participation of 63 accredited universities marked that HGEAIS program had entered a new cycle. 22 universities applied for initial HGEAIS program in 2021. Newly developed tools were implemented throughout the self-assessment phase, ensuring more matched and benchmarked information could be submitted by universities against accreditation standards



The Training on Higher Education for International Students in China

Higher Vocational Education Accreditation for International Students in China (HVEAIS) program and Basic Medical Education (in English Medium) Accreditation for International Students in China (BMEAIS) program moved forward steadily. The first batch of applicant colleges and universities for both programs completed training and have been conducting the self-assessment. BMEAIS was officially launched to facilitate Chinese MOE to carry out dynamic and standardized management on universities approved to provide basic medical education (in English Medium) program for international students in China. Among those universities, nearly half of them have applied for joining BMEAIS.

The Higher Education Evaluation for International Students in China (HEEIS) program was efficiently developed in 2021 and served 11 universities and colleges in Yunnan Province. Based on the HGEAIS and HVEAIS, HEEIS further expanded the scope of CEAIE's service to assure quality of study in China.

CEAIE collaborated with local EAIEs to jointly promote and carry out accreditation programs. The database of accreditation experts for HEAIS was further expanded to nearly 600 people.

To improve the bilingual education in China, Certificate for Bilingual Teachers Competency was launched officially in 2021, open to 7 colleges and 8 international educational institutions with a total of 6,020 exam positions.

Quality Monitoring of Chinese-foreign Cooperation in Running Schools

CEAIE compiled Annual Report of Chinese-foreign Cooperation in Running Schools, the Quality Assurance of Chinese-foreign Cooperation in Running Schools, and reports on other relevant education monitoring and evaluations. In 2021, CEAIE completed the follow-up quality assurance of Fuzhou Melbourne Polytechnic,

signed agreements with 8 universities and 6 colleges in conducting quality assurance for joint institutions and programs.

CEAIE supported Suzhou Centennial College and other colleges to initiate and establish the joint meeting of Chinese-foreign cooperation in running schools and project leaders in Higher Vocational Colleges (CJCCTVET) to continually promote the standardized development and improve the quality and efficiency of Chinese-foreign cooperation in running schools.

Entrusted by the Education Department of Henan Province, Guangxi Zhuang Autonomous Region and Inner Mongolia Autonomous Region, CEAIE carried out online and offline research and evaluation on joint institutions and programs, and inter school exchange projects, covering universities, vocational colleges and high schools.
